



TC10K Road Closures for Sunday, April 28, 2019

We are reaching out to you because your business is on, or in the general area of, the route of this year's TC10K. We want to make sure you have all the information for event day, and let you know of possible interruptions for you during the event. This document will outline the specifics of the TC10K on the date of the event.

The 30th Annual TC10K will take place on Sunday April 28, 2019. As in year's past there is both a 10K and a shorter approximately 1.5 km Family Run.

TC10K Route

The 10K route starts at Government (at the crosswalk between the BC Legislature and the BC Museum) heading north on Government to Yates Street, east on Yates, south on Vancouver, east on Richardson, then right on Minto, south on Moss, east on May, south on Memorial to Dallas Rd. The course then continues along Dallas, finishing in front of the B.C. Legislative Buildings on Belleville (map below).

The finish area will be on Belleville between Government and Menzies. This section will be closed from noon on Saturday through till Sunday at 2 p.m. in addition the area on Belleville from Government to Douglas will also be closed Sunday morning from 5:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.

The start area on Government Street (between Belleville and Superior) will be closed from 5 am until 2 pm on Sunday April 28th. Superior from Douglas to Menzies will be closed at 7:00 a.m. - 8:30 a.m. and then for the Family Run at 10:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. All intersections along the race route will also be closed. Roads inside of the race route will remain open, but motorists will have to cross the route at intervals from the direction of the police or traffic control personnel until roads have officially re-opened. Pedestrians will still be able to cross the race course, though there may be some delays.

There will be no on-street parking on the race route from 4 am until 11:00 am on Sunday, April 28. All cars parked on the race route during this time will be towed at the owner's expense based on event signage. This applies equally to the Family Run which begins at 11:00 a.m., those affected roads will be until noon.

The current race course offers a significant advantage to motorists in that it allows for rolling openings of roadways as soon as the last runners pass through various points along the route.

All streets on the race course will be closed as of 7:45 am on Sunday, April 28. Re-opening times will vary by location. The following is a list of approximate opening times:

The City of Victoria will be posting no parking signs on the course two days prior to the event to ensure that all residents are notified of road closures. The Victoria Police Department and Island Traffic Control will be assisting with traffic control for this important community event, to ensure the safety of all participants.

Thrifty Foods Family Run

The Thrifty Foods Family run starts at 11:00 am on Government – the same start as the 10K. Participants head south on Government to Superior. They turn right on Superior to Oswego, where they turn right on Oswego to Belleville, following Belleville to the TC 10K finish line. Roads will be opened behind the last participant. Superior will be fully closed from 10:30 am to noon. Oswego will be closed from 11:00 am to noon.
